Old Business

Principal Report

1. EQAO results still pending; Principal to share the results as soon as they are released. Not just the school, but the boards throughout the province.
2. Jungle Sport in progress. Forms are completed and sent in for March to have the event in May 2025
3. Progress Reports go home on the Nov 18th- Interviews Nov 20th and 21st - TBD by teachers via emails through classes.
4. Secure School Protocol - fire drills for safety of exiting the building. Hold and Secure (regular activities take place; outside threat, no entry in/out of the building), Lockdown (quiet and hold, no entry in/out of the building, classes are secured with no entry) 2 every year.
5. MathUp Licenses (every teacher has one), Know Your Code (work in progress with curriculum based school budget)
6. School Improvement Planning- well-being, literacy, and math
7. PCWB Consultant will be coming to the school to achieve the Ontario Healthy Schools certification
8. Inquiry project - the principals will be monitoring a program with focus on anti-black racism through Dr. Nicole Westburn
9. Lexia Training and PD release - tier 2 intervention. Specific students however teachers are permitted to use this for all students.
10. Values Assembly - Nov 19th recognizing students who demonstrated the pillars of HWDSB.
